



2026-27 Financial Aid

As Junction City School of Dance celebrates its 20th year, our team remains committed to providing tuition reductions and need-based scholarships to low-income and no-income families and single parents who can't afford dance for their children without financial assistance.

As we seek to meet the growing demand for tuition reductions (up to 50% off tuition) and to be responsible with the scholarship funds entrusted to us by sponsors (partial and full assistance with tuition and registration, recital, and costume fees), we have changed the financial aid application process for the 2026-2027 dance year. **Please carefully read the details below before completing your application.**

- **Requests for assistance should be submitted via email to jcschoolofdance@gmail.com no earlier than August 10 and no later than September 13.** Previous applicants and recipients must submit a new application each year.
- Applicants can expect a response on or before September 21 after the JCSD executive team has prayed over and carefully evaluated the requests. Financial needs that pop up later in the season will be considered; however, the allotted tuition reductions and need-based scholarships have usually been handed out before the end of September.
- Payment for the first month of tuition and all fees is due on the day you register for classes; however, we are aware that this may pose a difficulty for some families. Beginning August 10, you may **declare a financial hardship via email to jcschoolofdance@gmail.com**. While you wait to hear back on your financial aid application, we will work with you to get your dancers enrolled in one class each. If a tuition reduction or need-based scholarship is offered, your account will be credited for September and adjusted for the remaining months of the dance year.
- All recipients must be enrolled in auto-pay and will face a \$10 late fee if the payment cannot be processed on the 5th of the month, beginning in October. The December 5th charge will include the second half of the costume fee(s). Charges



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accrued between May 5 and May 31 (tickets, merchandise, etc.) will be processed on June 5.

- Recipients are not eligible for additional discounts, including but not limited to unlimited family rates and the pay-in-full discount.
